The Great Basin was engineered to achieve maximum grease storage efficiency in a smaller footprint product, providing significant installation and continued maintenance savings. The Great Basin also provides the industry's only lifetime warranty against corrosion and for structural integrity. It is manufactured in New Berlin, Wisconsin USA from rotationally molded High-Density Polyethylene, and features standard H-20 covers for heavy traffic installations, as well as custom extensions for deeper inverts.
